Isaiah 65: 1 "I revealed myself to those who did not ask for me; I was found by those who did not seek me."

Romans 3: 28 "For we maintain that a person is justified by faith apart from the works of the law."

In order for man to seek God in earnest and to ask for him in truth, it is necessary:

not that man do it in a particular 'religious' fashion, because the truth which Israel's history turned up is that natural man does not ask for God nor seek him, quite the opposite;

nor, therefore, that God just accommodate himself to human seeking as if that was basically on the right track;

but this, that God overcomes in man that which is inimical to him – does "not ask for him" and does "not seek him".

That is why seeking God starts here: "God was in Christ and reconciled the world to himself." And why Jesus points out: "No one comes to the Father except through me." Because we don't come to him except he come to us. In Christ God removes the separation; and when we seek God in Christ, we shall not fail to find him.
