


DEAR MEMBER/FRIEND OF THE WEST CHURCH,

As I'm preparing this newsletter we are in the time of Ascension and Pentecost. We are also, of course, in a time of change – some changes impending, some already underway – which will affect the way church will be done in our region and nationally. The CofS map is being redrawn. It is only natural that questions are asked, a reliable footing sought for navigating what is coming. Where are we, what's happening, where are we going? Hopefully this newsletter, and others still to come, will manage to pass on some relevant information and to give you an idea of where things are at.

Yet for the navigation of what is coming, if it is to be for the glory of God as surely it ought to be and has every possibility of being (!), the requirement is not just for us to be informed – it is renewal. Hence the mention of that "other" time, of Ascension and Pentecost. "Be renewed in the spirit of your minds" (Eph.4:23), says Paul, calling the church to opt for transformation, for change, in one's own self, one's inner being – a transformation which issues in a new way of understanding, of being in the world and going about life. As Paul makes clear when he adds: "and ... put on the new self, created after the likeness of God in true righteousness and holiness." (v.24)

This option has come into existence and has become available to all the church through Christ's ascension into heaven and through the coming of the Holy Spirit to the church from there. And all avail themselves of this option through union with Jesus Christ by faith in him. Christ in-forming the believer, that is what it means 'to be renewed in the spirit of your minds'. Which is why it is so important to immerse oneself often and enduringly in the life, work and word of our Lord and to do so with a good and seeking heart.

There are many young mums in the town and living with a small baby can be very lonely. The B&T group is a safe place where they can meet other mums and the children can socialise. There is home baking every week for the mums with tea or coffee and fresh fruit and crispy snacks with juice for the little ones. We don't have an entrance fee but give them the opportunity of giving a donation towards the snacks.

We have been overwhelmed with the generosity of the response and now the hall is full of toys for every age from newborn to 4-years old every Thursday morning. 


