'This statement shows the indestructible nature of true, saving faith. In the midst of circumstances that Job did not understand, he nevertheless fell back on the most basic truth of the gospel – his Redeemer lives! When the storms of life are intense and there does not seem to be any end in sight, the Christian must affirm that Christ is his Redeemer. Redemption brings to mind the glorious truth that the Christian is owned by God, purchased with his own blood (Act 20,28; 1Cor.6,20; Eph.1,14). And he must make such an affirmation on a personal level. Can you say, "I know that my Redeemer lives"? Is he yours?'
