Leviticus 19:18 "'Do not seek revenge or bear a grudge against one of your people, but love your neighbour as yourself. I am the Lord.'"

James 2: 8, 9 "If you really keep the royal law found in Scripture, 'Love your neighbour as yourself, you are doing right. But if you show favouritism, you sin and are convicted by the law as law-breakers.'"

Moses was given by God a long list of dos and don'ts for living a holy, Godly life. Every aspect of human behaviour was covered. Later Jesus summed them all up by saying that "...Love your neighbour as yourself..." Matthew 22:39(part)

James emphasises the point. Treat everybody equally and with love whether rich or poor, old or young, passive or aggressive, healthy or lame. Do not favour one above another.
