2Chr.25,8: "God has the power to help or to overthrow."

Rom.8,34: "Who then is the one who condemns? No one. Christ Jesus who died – more than that who was raised to life – is at the right hand of God and is also interceding for us."

God has the power to help. But does Amaziah, king of Judah hear it, who has just hired a small Israelite army to deliver for him the help he fails to seek from God?

God has the power to overthrow. Does Amaziah hear God's judgment on his plan should he decide to go ahead regardless of God's word to him / to His people?
