Luke 2: 28-30 "Simeon took him in his arms and praised God, saying:

'Sovereign Lord, as you have promised,

you now dismiss your servant in peace.

For my eyes have seen your salvation,'"

Image the scene. The courtyard of the temple bustling with priests, temple officials, the devout and all manner of merchants and hangers on. There would have been noise and dust from the pigeons, doves and sheep brought by young parents bringing their first born sons to fulfil the Law of the Lord. Mary and Joseph must have been anxious as they clutched their sacrificial offerings.
