Psalm 57:4 "I am in the midst of lions; I lie among ravenous beastsmen whose teeth are spears and arrows, whose tongues are sharp swords."

Proverbs 25:18 "Like a club or a sword or a sharp arrow is the man who gives false testimony against his neighbour."

Proverbs 12:18 "Reckless words pierce like a sword, but the tongue of the wise brings healing."
